Waiver Register

Waiver Register

Directlink is a Transmission Network Service Providers (TNSPs) and provides transmission services under the National Electricity Law (NEL). Directlink must therefore comply with the Australian Energy Regulator's (AER) Ring-fencing Guideline for Electricity Transmission (Version 4) that was published by the AER on 1 March 2023 (the Guideline).

Clause 5.7 of the Guideline requires a TNSP to establish and maintain a register of all waivers (including any variation of a waiver) granted to the TNSP by the AER and make that register publicly available. The register must include:

- the description of the conduct to which the waiver or interim waiver applies; and
- the terms and conditions of the waiver or interim waiver

This document is Directlink's waiver register in accordance with clause 5.7 of the Guideline.
