

Some outlines of potential governance structures for stakeholder consideration and modification

## INTRODUCTION

APA is presenting options for Governance/Decision making arrangements for the Stakeholder Engagement Group. These options aren't intended to be definitive or a list for stakeholder selection but rather are intended to be a springboard for stakeholders consideration of the issues that APA is raising.

## **WORKING GROUP**

#### Description

Informal group of interested participants who attend, and provide feedback on subjects workshops, information sessions and read written papers

#### Scope/topics for content of consultation

Topics set by APA subject to feedback from the working group. Similar to Murraylink, RBP or VTS

#### **Timeframes**

Set by APA subject to feedback from working group

#### **Comments**

Risk that content and format are determined by APA or a vocal minority of stakeholders limiting the scope of feedback.

This would require this workshop to define scope and timeframes.

Requires no prior ongoing commitment from individual stakeholders to participate in the stakeholder engagement going forward

## FORMAL PANEL

#### Description

A group of consumer representatives would be selected to form a formal panel (similar to a board). The representatives would give a commitment for the duration of the revenue determination. APA would provide the secretariat for the Formal Panel. Workshops and papers would be open to any interested party.

#### Scope/topics for content of consultation

The selection of topics for discussion and analysis would be selected by the Formal Panel. Either by majority vote or consensus.

The method for consultation on different topics would also be selected by the Formal Panel

#### **Timeframes**

The timing of consultations would be determined by the Formal Panel.

#### **Comments**

Requires a commitment of time by the members of the Formal Panel. Would require stakeholders to nominate themselves to participate on the panel. Would require at least 3 stakeholders to form a panel.

## **HYBRID**

#### Description

Stakeholder representatives at workshops would be the decision maker.

#### Scope/topics for content of consultation

A part of each consultation would be devoted to the selection of topics and format for the next consultation. This may be against a scope set as part of this consultation.

#### **Timeframes**

The timing of consultations would be determined by APA based on the resource requirements of the topics and formats selected by the stakeholder engagement group.

#### **Comments**

There may be issues of consistency of decision making as the composition of decision making will be determined by who is involved in individual consultations.
